### **DRILL RECAP**

On March 17<sup>th</sup>, 35 members of the SCHMRT assembled at CalFire Station 43 for the regular monthly drill which started at 0900 hrs. CalFire, Shasta County Fire, CHP, and Redding Fire were represented.

The drill started with a general team meeting and an in-depth post-incident review of the Court Street incident (02/25/10). Among the many positive comments on our general operation were some constructive points that we have already started to work on.

Following this review, the members completed a detailed inventory of the trailer at Station 43 that contains a significant amount of HM equipment for the SCHMRT. We now have updated inventory records for the trailer to match the updated inventory records for HM-24.

### **GENERAL SCHMRT UPDATE**

I am pleased that our attendance at monthly drill continues to be brisk. For reasons beyond our control, we will be deviating from the normal "3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday" drill schedule for the next two months (April and May). On April 14<sup>th</sup>, the SCHMRT will meet at the Community Room at Redding City Hall for a team-wide orientation. On May 12<sup>th</sup>, the SCHMRT will participate in a "disaster drill" at the Redding US Post Office facility along with a number of other local agencies. I will send you details on this drill in the near future.

As I write this report, HM-24 is in the shop for repairs and maintenance. The unit is available from the shop and our members have received information on how to retrieve HM-24 in the event of an activation. I expect it to be back in service at RFD Station 8 today. My appreciate to Battalion Chief Packwood for initiating the necessary arrangements for repairs to HM-24.
