## **DRILL RECAP**

On April 14<sup>th</sup>, 39 members of the SCHMRT assembled at Redding City Hall Community Room for the regular monthly drill which started at 0900 hrs. CalFire, Shasta County Fire, Shasta County SO, CHP, and Redding Fire were represented.

This drill was a comprehensive all-in-one "Orientation" of the SCHMRT as defined in the Operations Manual. Certainly, nothing good can be said about me lecturing for 5½ hours, so my deep appreciation for the good turnout and the patience from our members in getting through the day. All attendees "passed" the Orientation session. We focused on the Operations and Administration Manuals and covered the organizational structure of SCHMRT, specific operations, funding, and many other details about the team.

I could not think of more creative ways to deliver the mostly mundane information contained in the SCHMRT manuals – so long lecture it was.

## **GENERAL SCHMRT UPDATE**
