Subject: August 2009 SCHMRT Drill Recap

On August 19, 2009, 23 members of the SCHMRT assembled at RFD Station 8 for the regular monthly drill which started at 0900 hrs. Due to several Nor Cal fire incidents, a number of fire personnel were unable to attend this drill. Still, CalFire, Shasta County Fire, Shasta County Sheriff's, CHP, and Redding Fire were represented.

The drill topic was "circuit stations" and all participants rotated through four (4) different stations: MSA SCBA Use, Unknown Liquid ID, Davis Weather Station Operation, IS MX-6 Atmospheric Monitor.

You may have noticed that the new MX-6 detector is once again on the training agenda. The reason for this is that the MX-6 is a brand new atmospheric monitor that our crews must become very comfortable with. Provided some of our Homeland Security funds materialize we will purchase additional MX-6 monitors so that we can retire our aging cache of TMX-412 monitors. As previously mentioned, the MX-6 monitor that we use has an upgrade which includes a photoionization detector (PID) which can measure volatile organic compounds in ppm and even determine lower explosive limits in unknown atmospheres – this is a critical upgrade to our current capability. Just another tool in our chest when handling the risky world of unknown chemicals. We will continue to train on the MX-6 until our personnel are very comfortable with the operation of the unit.

Besides circuit stations, the team worked very hard on the inventory for HM-24. I am pleased with the efforts and results and feel that we have a good grasp on the inventory and condition of our equipment on HM-24. The changes to the current inventory sheets are so numerous that it will take some time for me to release an update. As soon as I am able to update the inventory sheets I will forward them out to the team. Many thanks to our members for taking on the essential project.

Keith was charged with overseeing the MSA SCBA refresher station. Covered the basic operations of the MSA SCBA and answered questions from the membership. Thank you Keith.

3. *Davis Weather Station (Mike Anderson)*

Mike was charged with showing the membership how to setup and properly operate the mobile Davis Weather Station on HM-24. Thank you Mike.

4. *Unknown Liquid Identification (Steve Howard)*

Steve was charged with the unknown liquid identification station – he prepared an “unknown liquid compound” and asked members to work through the HazCat steps to identify the general compound family. Thank you Steve.

5. *MX-6 Monitor (Rik Valles)*

Our Technical Reference Group Leader walked us through the operation of the MX-6 multigas monitor and PID. Thank you Rik.
