## DRILL RECAP



On August 18<sup>th</sup> members of SCHMRT assembled at RFD Station 5 for the August monthly drill. 43 SCHMRT members from the CHP, CalFire, Shasta County Fire, Redding Fire, and Red Bluff Fire were represented. As you might recall, HM-24 has been moved to our "new home" at RFD Station 5.

Topic of the drill was "circuit stations". Members rotated through the following stations:

- **Haz Cat Kit** – Unknown Identification
- **LEVEL A Suits** – Encapsulated suit time for all members
- **Instrument Operations** – Members refreshed their skills and knowledge on a number of instruments, including AIR, RAD, pH).
- **HEINZ 5-Step** – Unknown Identification
- **HM-24 Walkthrough** – Opportunity for each member to go through the HM rig and refresh on inventory and all equipment.



## TEAM TYPING

The Team Typing project is moving forward steadily – we have produced a complete inventory list of equipment needs for both Type III and Type II consideration and have forwarded this list to the SCHMRT Program Manager. The next phase is to purchase all of the needed equipment and then schedule the audit with CalEMA. I foresee this all to occur after this current fire season ends. I am very appreciative of the assistance provided to me by the SCHMRT members in this effort. Literally hundreds of hours of time have gone into this project so far.

New pH digital meters – we've decided to commit those entirely to the HM-24 lab for technical reference and not use them for field application.

Doug Martin from SKU is working on a donation of 4-5 railcar domes from Union Pacific in Roseville which will provide the SCHMRT with outstanding future training opportunities – these domes will be our own to play with. The domes consist of all of the main configurations currently in use on the railroad, including chlorine. Although we have not yet decided where these training props will be permanently stored I consider this to be a giant step forward in terms of our training and preparation for railroad incidents.
