DRILL RECAP

On September 15th members of SCHMRT assembled at Wheelabrator Shasta Energy Co Inc. in Anderson for the September monthly drill. 42 SCHMRT members from the CHP, Cal Fire, Shasta County Fire, Siskiyou County Public Health, Anderson Fire, Redding Fire, and Red Bluff Fire were present.

Under the supervision of Dr. Teri Ard, Health and Safety Manager at Wheelabrator, and her very helpful staff, the SCHMRT members toured the facility and then setup three different training stations:

1. Level A Suit Exercise
2. A-Kit Application Exercise
3. Anhydrous Ammonia Station

On behalf of the SCHMRT I wish to thank Dr. Ard and her staff for their gracious hospitality (including OJ and doughnuts!). We look forward to future drills at Wheelabrator Shasta Energy Co Inc.

LEVEL A EXERCISE STATION



This was a combination Level A Suit Station / Physical Agility station. Members were asked to don full Level A PPE and ascend a steep staircase at the plant. The intent here was to maintain their familiarity in full Level A attire and also present them with some physical challenges as well.

I was very pleased that nearly all of the participants climbed the full 4 stories to the top of the plant. Good effort by everyone.

ANHYDROUS AMMONIA STATION



Wheelabrator uses anhydrous ammonia as part of their emissions control effort. The ammonia scrubs sulfur dioxide and nitrogen oxides from the smoke stacks and dramatically reduces these emissions. Personnel reviewed the location, safety hazards, and emergency operations when dealing with this chemical. Many thanks to our own John Boshell for his insight and real-world experience of this product.

A-KIT APPLICATION STATION



The A-kit is our “patch n plug” kit to stop leaks on smaller compressed gas cylinders (less than 150 lbs of product). The leaks can include sidewall ruptures, bad valves, and fusible plug blowouts. In the skilled hands of a hazmat team member, an A-kit can turn an ugly situation into a positive outcome and stop the release of a product in these smaller-sized cylinders.

A-kits differ from B-kits and C-kits mainly by the size of the container that they are applied to. B-kits are exclusive to chlorine and sulfur dioxide 1-ton cylinders (sewer plants). C-kits are exclusive for rail car tanks and domes. SCHMRT

carries all three types of these kits.

Noteworthy here is that RFD Captain Ron Utvick has completed the first of what will be many future SCHMRT Company Evolutions: A-Kit Application. Thank you Captain Ron! I will post this how-to guide on the www.schmrt.com website soon.

TEAM TYPING

The Team Typing project has slowed with no new progress to report. The next phase is to purchase all of the needed equipment and then schedule the audit with CalEMA. I foresee this all to occur after this current fire season ends. I am very appreciative of the assistance provided to me by the

SCHMRT members in this effort. Literally hundreds of hours of time have gone into this project so far.
