Subject: December 2009 SCHMRT Drill Recap

DRILL RECAP

On December 16, 31 members of the SCHMRT assembled at RFD Station 8 for the regular monthly drill which started at 0900 hrs. CalFire, Shasta County Fire, Red Bluff Fire, CHP, and Redding Fire were represented.

The drill topic again was "circuit stations" and members rotated through six (6) different stations:



STATION 1: SUITS

This station was primarily intended to give all members the opportunity for some Level A "suit time". Once encapsulated, members were presented with some basic obstacles and tasks to complete. As you might recall from last drill, SCHMRT members requested more suit training. Unless the team is engaged in a full-blown Level A drill, we will continue to provide a "suit station".



STATION 2: HM-24 SNOW CHAIN INSTALLATION

Appropriate for the season obviously, all members refamiliarized themselves with the installation of snowchains on HM-24.

STATION 3: DRAEGER TUBE REFRESHER

Draeger tubes are devices which may utilize to sample *known* compounds. To this extent, we

can confirm a presence of a chemical, such as ammonia or chlorine. Personnel at this station simply refreshed themselves on the steps necessary to prepare the Draeger tubes and draw samples.

STATION 4: NEW DOSIMETER FAMILIARIZATION

The original SCHMRT dosimeters had expired and could no longer be serviced by the manufacturer. So we replaced them with four new devices that are similar to the model used by our teammates in the California Highway Patrol. Dosimeters will continue to measure and record the presence of common sources of radiation during HM operations.

STATION 5: MEDICAL MONITORING

A repeat of a station that we have worked on for the past several drills, Medical Monitoring is a critical aspect of HM Operations. All personnel were evaluated through this station. Additionally, we further streamlined some med monitoring procedures by standardizing to new checklists.



STATION 6: ATMOSPHERIC MONITORS

Another visit to our atmospheric monitors. Both the MX-6 and the older TMX-412 monitors were utilized at the station. All personnel refreshed on the operating procedures of all of our atmospheric monitors. Following the drill, the SCHMRT atmospheric

monitors were re-calibrated by our Technical Reference personnel.

STATION 7: NEW MEMBERS: INVENTORY FAMILIARIZATION

This station was designed to give our new SCHMRT members a chance for some "alone time" exploring the inventory on HM-24.

SCHMRT DRILL NEEDS AND TO-DO-LIST:

1. Pending HM-24 repairs
2. Oral Glucose in med monitoring boxes needs to be replaced
3. Take Med Monitoring forms to city Reprographics Dept and create a "form pad" for convenient data entry.
4. Post new dosimeter manual on www.schmrt.org

5. HM-24 needs some bailing wire (1 spool)
6. HM-24 needs 2nd snowchain wrench
7. HM-24 needs three (3) 25-ft Ethernet cables
8. Captain McMurtrey will be assisting Engineer Moore with suit testing
