Subject: September 2009 SCHMRT Drill Recap

On Sep 16, 2009, 40 members of the SCHMRT assembled at RFD Station 8 on Churn Creek Rd for our monthly drill which started at 0900 hrs.

The drill was another circuit-station style training to refresh our team on additional critical operations.

During one of our circuit stations, our mechanical RC car "Hazmo", which can be used to "scoop and deliver" an unknown substance via remote control, broke a tie rod and was placed OOS. As an alternative station, RFD Captain Anderson quickly switched his station to familiarize the team with the new mount and operation for the weather station.

Overall, I was once again very pleased with the training results and the cohesion and cooperation of the members.

Team Meeting Minutes

There was no "team meeting" per-se, since there were no new items to discuss. I did announce that our next SCHMRT training (Oct 21) will hopefully be held in Siskiyou County. Details will follow once our Siskiyou County members secure a site of the team.

Circuit Stations

- **Air Monitor Operation – TMX-412 (M. Sawyer)**
 - This station reviewed the operation and preparation of our older TMX-412 air monitors which are still operational on HM-24.
- **Air Weather Station (M. Anderson)**
 - I am pleased to inform the team that the sensors for the weather station have a permanent mount on the roof of HM-24 where they belong. The signal from these sensors is now fed down into the Tech Ref room for accurate and continuous weather readings on the receiver. We also have ordered the cable and software to interface with our laptop and help predict plume distribution and evacuation zones. Many thanks to

Captain Anderson for a job well-done on this one – great to have his enthusiasm and construction skills!

- **Unknown Identification Station (M. Blair)**
 - Back to basics – we will have an unknown chemical ID station at nearly every SCHMRT drill – the foundation of what we are about is to be able to do some basic ID on unknowns. This time the team was given an unknown (zirconium oxide) and was asked to ID the family using Haz Cat techniques.

- **HM-24 Operations (K. Ward)**
 - How to properly deploy the HM-24 awning. How to properly deploy the light mast. How to properly engage the generator. How to setup the many pieces of equipment on HM-24 was the purpose of this station to ensure that we perform our duties safely and effectively.

- **Radiological Equipment (B. Boyes, M. Gould)**
 - All of our stations were great on Wed, but Bill and Mike could make a week-long class out of radiological equipment use with their knowledge and enthusiasm. Great job.

My deep appreciation to all of the station proctors during this drill. Many thanks to all SCHMRT members who attended this drill and who continue to support the team. I also wish to thank all of the allied and cooperative agencies who continue to assist and participate in the SCHMRT program, despite these very challenging financial times.
